When will the school re-open?

It appears we will find out on Monday, 22nd February, details of when the school can open further to more children.

We will be in touch as soon as possible to confirm this increased re-opening of the school.

We look forward to welcoming all children back as soon as we can in line with Government guidance.

When will remote learning re-start?

Remote learning will re-start on Monday, 22nd February, for children not in school.
