Singing forms an important part of our school life. Weekly hymn practices include both modern and traditional hymns and singing is a particular feature of our celebration assemblies. The school choir takes part in local festivals and performing in the community. KS1 perform Nativities involving singing, acting and musical accompaniments. Pupils are given further opportunities to perform in KS2, with an Easter Play and Y6 end of year musical.

KS2 have the opportunity to learn to read standard notation through playing the recorder and keyboard in whole class lessons. Music projects allow pupils to further develop their understanding of music through listening and evaluating, composing and performing both individually and in groups.

Pupils are encouraged to share their diverse cultural backgrounds through music and dance, performing in assemblies and in our annual International Day.

Working with Milton Keynes Music Cooperative, we are able to offer pupils the opportunity to learn to play violin, guitar and flute. Ensemble club encourages pupils to join their individual talents in collective music making.
