Dear Parent/Carer

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Heathy school food has obvious health benefits and can help pupils establish healthy habits for life. Healthy school food can also help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.

Registering for free meals will trigger Pupil Premium income of £1,345 per child for the school to provide valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities. This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed below.

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- An income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (not including Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tac Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Currently all children in Reception and Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to universal free school meals regardless of income but it is still important to apply if you receive any of the above benefits as this will trigger additional funding for the school and ensure your child continues to receive free school meals through to the end of year 6 at St Monica's Catholic Primary School.

To check if your child is eligible, we need information about you and your child. Please complete the form attached and return to school and we will do the rest. Alternatively, you can apply yourself at the following website https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims please apply separately for each parent / person with parental responsibility.

How the information in this form will be used

The information you provide in this form will be used by us to confirm receipt of one of the listed welfare benefits. Once this is confirmed, this helps to decide how much money your child's school will receive each year.
